

**Special Weather Statement – Susitna Valley**

- Significant rises on Susitna Valley rivers expected over the next couple of days. Several days of moderate rainfall are forecast for the western Susitna River valley which includes the Yentna, Skwentna, and Chulitna Rivers. Rainfall totals between 2 and 4 inches are expected through Wednesday with higher amounts possible in mountainous terrain. Rivers and streams in this area are expected to rise significantly in response to this rainfall, with water levels on the Yentna River possibly reaching bankfull towards the middle of this week.

High surf advisories are in effect for the following areas:

- Chukchi Sea Coast – in effect until 12 AM Tuesday
- St Lawrence Island and the Bering Strait Coast – in effect until 6 AM Tuesday

Flood advisories are in effect for the following areas:

- Northwestern Brooks Range – in effect until 2:15 PM today
- Upper Kobuk and Noatak valleys – in effect until 2:15 PM today
- Lower Kobuk and Noatak valleys – in effect until 2:15 PM today

Wind advisories are in effect for the following areas:

- Deltana and Tanana Flats – in effect until 6 AM Tuesday
- Eastern Alaska Range – in effect until 6 AM Tuesday
