

- Southern Seward Peninsula Coast – in effect from noon today through 6 AM Saturday.
- St Lawrence Island and Bering Strait Coast – in effect until 6 AM Saturday.
- Chukchi Sea Coast – in effect from noon today through 10 AM Saturday.
- Lower Kobuk and Noatak Valleys – in effect from noon today through 10AM Saturday.

A High Wind Watch is in effect for the Central Aleutians from Saturday evening through Sunday evening.
